## Volunteer Nanny Program

We have a Nanny Program for our baby goats. Steffie is our Head Nanny and can be reached at [xlizardqueen@gmail.com](mailto:xlizardqueen@gmail.com) if anyone is interested. It is a great way to get the farm experience without the financial or long term commitment. Minimum age is (mature and well behaved) 12 with an adult present.

**Program Description:** Our Nanny Program is a minimum three (3) month commitment. The current three months will end in February but we will be needing another group starting in February 2015. We also need a few to fill in some shifts in the current program. As it stands now, it looks like we will be kidding babies through June (just bred Peaches today which gives her a June 3 delivery date) and bottles through summer. We need volunteers for morning and evening shifts seven days a week. You can volunteer for as many or as few shifts as you're able to. Shift times are *a little* flexible depending on everyone's availability and as long as our kids are well taken care of.

The responsibilities of a Nanny are briefly listed below.

### Morning Shift ≈ 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM

- Baby Feedings at approximately 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM (changes depending on age)
- Preparing milk bottles/lambars for the following shift.
- Coccidia treatments (oral medication)
- Heat treating/Pasteurizing mother's milk from the morning milking shift
- Cleaning out the toddler or kinder stalls as scheduled
- Checking up on expectant mothers and assisting with delivery of newborns
- Baby Laundry

### Evening Shift ≈ 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM

- Baby Feedings at approximately 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM (changes depending on age)
- Preparing milk bottles/lambars for the following shift.
- Coccidia treatments (oral medication)
- Worm treatments (oral medication)
- Heat treating/Pasteurizing mother's milk from the evening milking shift
- Cleaning out the newborn area as scheduled
- Checking up on expectant mothers and assisting with delivery of newborns
- Baby Laundry
